Farm Water Pricing & Guaranteed Supply

Reliable water. One statewide price. Stronger farms, jobs, and California food growth.

- 1. Full water delivery with advance notice.** MACA will require water districts to honor confirmed farmer requests when filed in advance so growers can plan irrigation, protect crops, and avoid sudden cutoffs during the season.
- 2. One statewide price of \$345.00 per acre-foot.** Every water district will follow the same MACA farmer rate so California growers are not punished by unequal local pricing for the same basic need.
- 3. Governor-backed district accountability.** Water districts will be backed by the Governor's Office and directed to deliver approved agricultural water with no arbitrary exceptions when supply has been scheduled and confirmed.
- 4. Water first for California crop production.** MACA will prioritize dependable farm water for working fields so growers can plant with confidence, keep land productive, and strengthen California food output.
- 5. Grow for California families and California GDP.** Reliable irrigation will help farmers produce more vegetables, fruit, feed, and field crops in-state, increasing farm sales, local processing, and contribution to California's economy.
- 6. Clear monthly and annual reporting.** Participating farms will report acreage, crop output, and revenue so the state can measure water use, production gains, jobs supported, and the value added to California agriculture.
- 7. More jobs and stronger rural communities.** When water is dependable, farms hire, plant, harvest, pack, and deliver more product, supporting farmworkers, truckers, suppliers, and local businesses across California counties.
